

Pro Criança

In its 25 years of work, Pro Criança Cardíaca has provided care for 100 thousand outpatients and performed 1.6 thousand invasive procedures such as heart surgeries and diagnostic and therapeutic catheterization. Every month, the institution renders services for approximately 140 underprivileged children that are cared for by a multi-disciplinary team of health-care professionals and highly qualified cardiologists.

Non-profit medical institution, founded by the cardiologist Dr. Rosa Celia, who still leads the institution, was created because it was so difficult for her to say no to underprivileged families that sought her help in her private practice. Her desire to help made her look for means to make her dream come true.

One of her main goals was that the health facility was not exclusive for medical procedure but also a complete structure to meet the needs of the children as well as their families', offering a multidisciplinary care, including dentistry, dermatology, nutrition, psychology and ophthalmology. And to provide help for food, meds, diapers, books and toys.

The donations are essential to maintain the social project and to carry out the outpatients' care and other services provided for children and their families by this excellent social and philanthropic work, which also has a commitment with its staff and service providers in relation to humanized governance.

Cardiology

Inclusion process

The child or teenager with a suspicion or history of heart disease is referred by a pediatrician, family doctor or public sector cardio-pediatrician for a cardiological opinion. The first consultation in the Institution is free of charge and the appointment can be made by phone (21) 3239-4500 or through our website www.procrianca.org. br.

HEART CARE

In the first heart evaluation the patient is registered. Then, clinical examination, electrocardiogram and echocardiogram are performed. Once the diagnosis of cardiovascular disease is confirmed, management, treatment (clinical, medication and / or surgical) and patient follow-up will be carried out by the Institution.

Tests such as a 24-hour holter, exercise test, chest X-ray, angiotomography of the heart, heart MRI, laboratory tests, among others, can be performed to help in the diagnosis and therapeutic decision. Once the invasive procedure has been indicated by the cardiology team, being surgical correction, ablation or therapeutic catheterization, the case is discussed with the surgeon and / or hemodynamicist. Then the procedure is prescheduled.

During the process, the patients undergo the dentist's evaluation. It is essential that the patient with a heart disease has a good oral health. If the patient is clinically well, he is referred to Hospital Pediátrico Pro Criança Jutta Batista in the same day to collect blood and urine for lab tests and

chest x-ray. Due to the pandemics, it is necessary to perform the test for COVID-19 in the patient and their parents as well, the RT-PCR. The medical staff checks the test results and, if they are satisfactory, the invasive procedure is confirmed.

The invasive procedure and hospitalization

The surgery duration and hospitalization depend on the pathology's severity and any incident after surgery. Age and low body weight can also contribute for a longer hospitalization. On average, the length of hospital stay for uncomplicated cardiac surgery is 5 to 7 days and that for therapeutic catheterization is 2 to 3 days. During hospitalization, the medical staff clinically evaluates the patients, performing electrocardiograms and echocardiograms.

Hospital discharge

If everything was fine and there were no complications, it is time to go home! The return visit is scheduled to assess the patient and remove the stitches. The patient must continue with regular cardiological follow-up at the headquarters of the Pro Criança Cardíaca.

OUTPATIENT Dentistry

Founded in 2003 to treat underprivileged children and teenagers with heart disease, our dentistry staff is formed by a team of voluntary dentists who offer treatment to Pro Criança Cardíaca's patients for free.

Dermatology

In addition of treating skin diseases, the dermatologist treats the surgical wound, since scarring is often a delicate point for children and teenagers.

Nutrition

Nutritional individual evaluation offers the necessary calorie support for each patient with heart disease and overweight in addition to help families to keep healthy habits.

Ophthalmology

Pro Criança offers to children and teenagers ophthalmology care and glasses, when necessary, through a partnership with an optician shop. In the project, patient care is given in an integral way, which is better for the evolution and maintenance of the cardiological health of each patient.


Psychology


The psychology team offers support to the patient and their families, treating the psychological aspects associated with heart disease. We try to develop the resilience during the pre-surgical time, and promote the understanding regarding the disease itself, in addition to developing an acceptance related to the patients' activity restrictions. Conditions related to both emotional and socioeconomic needs are also addressed.


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

Successful stories

Davi, 4 years old, is Alessandra and Abraão's son. They live in Niterói. The pregnancy was not planned but the parents cheered it. They found out a congenital heart disease during the pregnancy and the father rejected the son.

Davi was born on September 2nd, 2017, and was diagnosed with complex heart disease. He needed ventilator support and medication to survive. It was extremely important that he was transferred to a hospital that carried out his heart surgery.

His family contacted Dr. Rosa Celia and four days after he was born, the boy was transferred to Hospital Pro Criança Jutta Batista. On September 11th, 2017, Davi underwent his 1st surgery and, in a month, he was discharged for outpatient follow-up.

After her maternity leave, the mother quitted her job to take care of her son. The father, despite conflicted, registered the son, but did not keep in touch. The only emotional support the mother can count on is from her aunt. The family survives with a basic wage paid by the Federal Government due to the little boy's health.

Davi was not like other boys of his age. His skin was purplish and it got worse with minimum exertion, and he got tired whenever he played... It would be necessary other invasive procedures as well as constant care.

In 2019, he underwent another surgery. Three years after that, he underwent another one. That last time, he underwent a catheterization to carry out Fontan procedure.

His surgery was carried out on February 2nd, 2022. The procedure was successful! It was the beginning of a new life, a victory after so many battles and long days on the ICU.



Now my heart is full of happiness! Davi made a full recovery and, from now on, everything will be better and he will live a long life. Thank you, Pro Criança! My son is everything to me, I could never live without him.

ALESSANDRA

Manuela, 9 years old, and her family live in São José do Vale do Rio Preto, in a city in the mountains of the state of Rio de Janeiro. She has a twin sister and another sister, four years older than she.

The monthly income of the whole family is two minimum wages. Roberta, the mother, is a psychologist who works in a private practice some days a week. The father owns a barber-shop, which was impacted by the pandemics. They live in a house owned by the paternal grandfather.

"When I was informed that she needed surgery, my first thought was that we couldn't afford it", Roberta said.

Manuela's treatment was made by SUS in her city. Her health always seemed stable but, after she was evaluated by a new doctor, she identified the need of further investigation in the heart. They went to see a pediatric cardiologist in their city and, after this, the patient was forwarded to Pro Criança, much to the mother's surprise:

"What surprised me the most was the welcome my daughter received and the fact that they already had a heart with her name on it. This was a miracle for us. They welcomed us, and I thank God and Pro Criança's team", Roberta said.

Manuela's first appointment at Pro Criança on September 29th, 2021, where the diagnosis of congenital heart disease was confirmed, sinus venosus interatrial communication (ASC), and she needed surgery.

Due to the donors' generosity, Manuela's surgery was carried out on November 22nd, 2021,

less than 2 months after her first appointment with the project's team. Now, her family is calmer, while Pro Criança's medical staff keep their follow-up.

What surprised me the most was the welcome my daughter received and the fact that they already had a heart with her name on it. This was a miracle for us.



After the creation of the Regulatory Framework for Civil Society Organizations, accountability in the third sector became even more fundamental for the survival of a social institution. Pro Criança Cardíaca respects the principle of transparency and credibility in all its social actions and considers its priority to show the donors how the resources were used. Each heart surgery, for example, must generate an accountability report for the donors and the public in general as follows.

Referral for surgery

By becoming the first patient in line for a heart surgery, Sophia went to pre-surgery.

The Institution's communication department asked permission for the use of her image and to follow the patient story to transform it in a full content that justifies the use of resources.

Training and edition of content

Sophia had several appointments, tests before and after the surgery. In addition to taking pictures, the Communication department interviewed the family, giving them the opportunity to tell their story, thank and establish a closer contact with the donor.

Publishing the content

After selecting and editing the recorded material, the video was shared with donors and, afterwards with the public in general, through Pro Criança's official channels (social media, site and e-mail).






